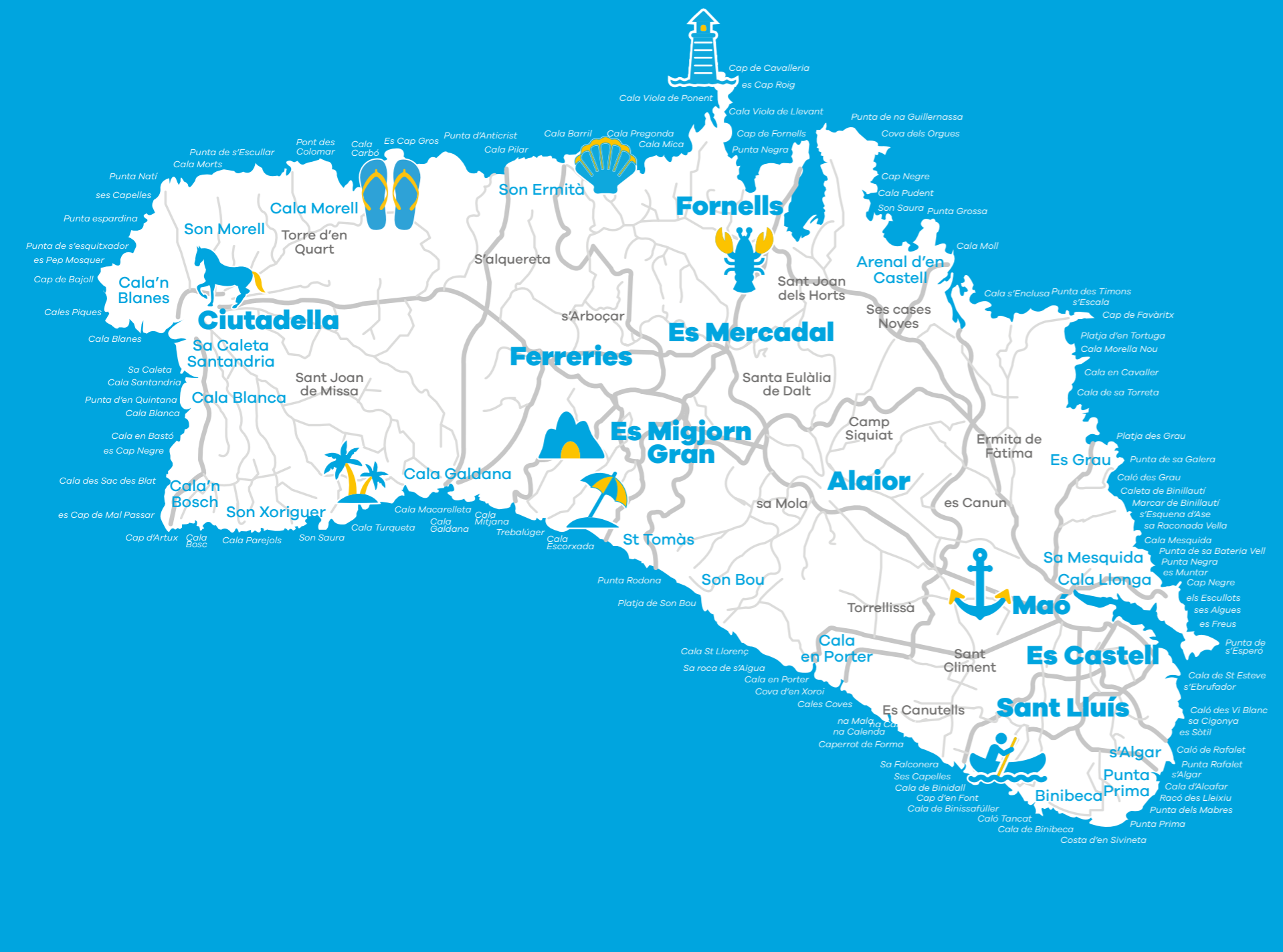


TOP 10 MINORCA



MAHÓN

Mahón is the capital of the island. It will be always a good idea to walk around the old town and go to shopping from Explanada Square until Ses Voltes Coast. Don't miss out to visit the port with a great variety of restaurants, clubs and pubs to enjoy the nightlife of the island.



BINIBECA VELL

It is fishing village located in Sant Lluís area. Binibeca Vell is well-known because by its small white houses placed in narrow streets so you might feel like in a labyrinth. Around this area there are several hidden coves where you can take a rest from the busy life.



PLAYA DE BINIGAUS

Located in the south of the island, it is a charming virgin beach with crystal water, gold sand and lush vegetation. To access this paradise, you will have to walk for 5 min through the neighborhood of Santo Tomás.



CUEVA DES COLOMS

This cave is in the Binigaus ravine close to Es Migjorn Gran village. Also, known as "La Catedral" whose dimensions are really impressive thanks to its 24 meters high. Reach the cave by walk taking around 20-30 mins.



CAVALLERIA LIGHTHOUSE

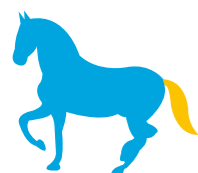
From this lighthouse, you can see the most breathtaking views of the north coast of the island. Also, it is the perfect place to enjoy magic sunsets and feel the tranquility of Menorca.



CALA ALGAIARENS

Located at the northwest of the island, only 10 km away from Ciutadella, you will discover this amazing cove surrounded by exuberant floral world and crystal water. If you fancy to take a "mud bath" in the middle of nature don't miss this gorgeous beach!

CIUTADELLA



Located in the west end of the island, well-known for its narrow streets which start at Plaça Nova or Plaça Espanya and end at Ciutadella Cathedral. Close to the City Hall the Plaça des Born is taking place from where you can also see the port. Find a wide range of restaurants and pubs in this town and enjoy.



FORNELLS

Fornells is the gastronomic capital of Menorca. The most famous dish is "calderta de langosta" - a kind of lobster stew - that made Fornells a famous town in Menorca. Moreover, the port of Fornells is the best place to practice different types of water sports.

CALES FROM THE SOUTH OF CIUTADELLA

(Macarella, Son Saura y Turqueta)



These beaches with crystal clear water, white sand and pine trees are located in 14 km away from Ciutadella. Those are the most famous of the island. Just in 10-minute walk from Macarella you will find Macarelleta which is smaller but nicer and less crowded so it's the perfect place to enjoy your beach day.



CALA PREGONDA

Considered the "Pearl of the North Coast" - a red-sand beach with rocks. You will find it after a 25-minute walk from Cala de Binimel·là. Being a virgin wild beach, you won't find any bar around it, so don't forget to bring enough drinks and food to relax the whole day!
